LOBBYIST - SHERRY MUNYON WAS IN ATTENDANCE AND PROVIDED A LEGISLATIVE UPDATE TO THE ASSEMBLY. SHE DISTRIBUTED A LISTING OF ITEMS THAT HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED AS POTENTIAL FOCUS ITEMS FOR THE FIRE SERVICE AND LOBBYIST TO WORK ON IN THE NEXT SESSION. IF THERE WERE ADDITIONAL IDEAS AS TO IMPORTANT ISSUES FOR REGION 15 – SHE WOULD WELCOME THOSE AS WELL. SHERRY COVERED ISSUES RELATED TO THE FIRE SAFETY ACCOUNT, FIRE STATE AID AS IT RELATES TO PENSION (2%), THE ONGOING IRS 990 ISSUE, AND OTHER MISC ITEMS.

BRUCE WEST PRESENTED INFORMATION RELATED TO THE EFFORTS OF THE MN FIRE SERVICE FOUNDATION FIREFIGHTER MEMORIAL. A SLIDESHOW WAS PRESENTED WITH DETAILS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION RELATIVE TO THE PROPOSED PROJECT. THE ORGANIZATION IS LOOKING TO RAISE \$600K TO BUILD A FIREFIGHTER MEMORIAL ON THE GROUNDS OF THE STATE CAPITOL.

Issues of State/National Interest:

MSFDA:

- o REGION DIRECTOR – TOM SMITH, UPDATED THE REGION OF ACTIVITIES OF THE ORGANIZATION. KEY ITEMS THAT TOM NOTED WERE: NEXT YEAR’S CONFERENCE WILL BE IN ALEXANDRIA – JUNE 14-16; BYLAW HAVE BEEN UPDATED; AND ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT HAS BEEN HIRED; AND MN LEGISLATIVE DAY AT THE CAPITOL IS SLATED FOR FEB. ADDITIONAL ACTIVITIES AND INVOLVEMENTS OF MSFDA CAN BE FOUND/VIEWED IN THE WEB SITE.

MSFCA:

- o REGION DIRECTOR (DESIGNATE) – STEVEN R JURRENS GAVE A BRIEF VERBAL REPORT, AND MADE MENTION TO VISIT THE MSFCA WEB SITE TO STAY CURRENT ON THE ACTIVITIES OF THE ORGANIZATION. JURRENS ALSO MENTIONED THAT THE CHIEF’S CONFERENCE IS FAST APPROACHING – OCT 20-22 - ST. CLOUD.

MINNESOTA STATE FIRE MARSHAL:

- o LOCAL INVESTIGATOR- STEVE WOLF PRESENTED AN UPDATE TO THE ASSEMBLY. TO DATE - 38 FIRE DEATHS. STEVE REFERENCED THE WEB SITE OF THE ORGANIZATION AND ALSO TOUCHED BASE ON “LIFE SAFETY” INITIATIVES. THERE HAVE BEEN A NUMBER OF VACANT HOUSE FIRES IN THE REGION (DODGE/STEELE COUNTYS) – KEEP AN EYE OUT AND BE AWARE OF THESE STRUCTURES. IF FIRE ORIGIN IS QUESTIONABLE – CONTACT THE MN STATE FIRE MARSHAL.

MN VOLUNTEER BENEFIT ASSOCIATION:

- o BRUCE BOYNTON – NOT IN ATTENDANCE / NO REPORT

MN STATE VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER ASSOCIATION:

- o DAVE GANFIELD SHARED A FEW POINTS RELATIVE TO THE ORGANIZATION AND REFERENCED VISITING THEIR WEB SITE. DAVE MADE MENTION THAT HE ALSO SERVES ON THE MN RELIEF ASSOC STEERING COMMITTEE – SO IF QUESTIONS/SUGGESTIONS ARISE, GIVE HIM A CALL -OR- SEND AN E-MAIL.

RIVERLAND COMMUNITY COLLEGE – FIRE/SAFETY:

- o BRIAN STASKA SHARED INFORMATION RELATIVE TO THE ACTIVITIES OF RIVERLAND IN THE REGION. MULTIPLE ON-LINE CLASSES ARE CURRENTLY IN SESSION FOR FFI/FFII. A NUMBER OF CHANGES/UPDATES HAVE OCCURRED TO THEIR WEB SITE – ENCOURAGED EVERYONE TO CHECK IT OUT. RIVERLAND NOW OFFERS A CERTIFICATION PROGRAM IN FIREFIGHTING (16 CR HRS) – CREDITS ARE TRANSFERABLE TO OTHER COLLEGES. WITH THE KICK-OFF OF THE NEW “CERT” PROGRAM, THE COLLEGE IS IN NEED OF SOME 2-1/2” HOSE FOR MISC TRAINING (HOSE DOES NOT NEED TO PASS PRESSURE TEST). ANOTHER NEED OF THE COLLEGE IS COMPRESSOR UNIT – SYSTEM IS NEED FOR BOTTLE REFILL. 2012 RIVERLAND STATE FIRE SCHOOL WILL BE IN ROCHESTER – MARCH 31 & APRIL 1. ALSO, WITH THE INCREASE OF TRAINING REQUEST BY DEPTS. IN THE REGION, RIVERLAND IS LOOKING TO ADD TO THEIR INSTRUCTIONAL STAFF – IF INTERESTED CONTACT BRIAN.

- o **DAVE SCHLIEK – NOT IN ATTENDANCE / NO REPORT. PRES. JURRENS DID SHARE THAT MFSCB IS IN THE PROCESS OF TRYING TO ESTABLISH A EVALUATOR TEAM FOR SOUTHERN MN. THIS COULD PROVIDE MORE TESTING DATE OPPORTUNITIES AND SHORTER TRAVEL DISTANCES FOR THOSE INDIVIDUALS IN OUR REGION.**
